

Minutes of Probate Court August Term, 1857.

The State of Alabama (Jay's County), Tuesday morning  
 nine o'clock 15<sup>th</sup> August 1857. Court met pursuant to adjournment  
 present the undersigned Judge of Probate the following proceedings were had to wit:

## Michael Wrights Estate

3 Mr. H. Wright appointed Administrator 15<sup>th</sup> August 1857

Come this day William H Wright and made application to said Court to appoint him Administrator on the Estate of Michael Wright late of said County deceased, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that it is necessary that an Administration should be had on said Estate, and that neither the Widow nor next of kin has applied for the same, and it further appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the said William H Wright has entered into bond in the sum of three thousand dollars conditioned as required by law, with John Savage and William A. Stokeland as securities therein which bond is hereby approved and ordered to be filed and recorded.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the said William H Wright be and he is hereby appointed Administrator of all and singular the goods and chattels rights and credits of Michael Wright late of said County deceased.

It is further ordered by the Court that Letters of Administration on all and singular the good and chattels rights and credits of Michael Wright deceased issue to the said William H Wright.

## Order of appraisement

Ordered by the Court that William A. Moore, Franklin Ogden and David S. Worklands be and they are hereby appointed appraisers of all and singular the goods and chattels rights and credits of Michael Wright late of said County deceased, and that they return their said appraisement to this Court at a regular term Monday to be held at the Court house in and for said County on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday in September next.
