ABOUT US



The Genealogical Society was founded in 1982 and is affiliated with the Chula Vista Library system. The Society has much to offer the community. We invite you to learn to do genealogy research, find documents, understand data in documents, find missing people in your family tree and share your heritage with other family members.

We utilize many resources for research including other libraries, The LDS Family History Centers, other Historical and Genealogical Societies, public records repositories and the Internet.

The society obtains books for the library through donations and purchases. To date the Society has made available to the library over 3000 books, manuscripts and periodicals for use in genealogy research.

The Society publishes a newsletter monthly, available to members and affiliated organizations by mail, email or on our Society website.

ACTIVITIES/EVENTS

1. We have a Genealogy Library within the Civic Center Library. Books are obtained through donations and purchases.
2. Society Researchers are available at the library to assist in your research:
Mondays 11 am - 1 pm or by appointment.
3. Beginners Classes are presented as needed or requested.
4. Queries are welcomed and answered by experienced Society members. Donations are accepted plus any expenses incurred while doing research (copies of documents, etc.)
5. The society has a research group to work on your most challenged areas of research. Join us on the Second Wednesday of each month from 12 pm – 2 pm in Room C1 at the Library.
6. Our computer group learns how to do research on the web. We welcome all levels of knowledge. Join us on the third Wednesday of each month from 12 pm – 2 pm either in the computer Lab or Room C1 at the Library.
7. Society members are cataloging the records of La Vista cemetery and have completed cataloging the records of Glen Abbey Cemetery which has been published in both book form and on CD.
8. Society members are also cataloging and archiving Estate Papers given to the Society by prominent genealogists of the area to be used for research.
9. The Society offers **field trips** to local genealogy libraries and hosts an annual picnic in the summer and a holiday party in December.
