From the South/West: On Hwy 49 North, take the Idaho-Maryland exit. Turn left at the Stop sign. Get in the right-hand turn lane and turn right at the roundabout and proceed ahead on to Main Street. Left on Hughes Rd. (at the signal). Veer right on Ridge Rd., approx. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the First Baptist Church (on your left).

From the North/East: On Hwy 49/20, take the East Main St. exit and continue thru the roundabout straight ahead onto Main Street; turn left on Hughes Rd. (at the signal). Veer right on Ridge Rd., approx. $\frac{1}{2}$ mile to the First Baptist Church (on your left).
