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SACRAMENTO COUNTY CEMETERIES

The following is from a book which I compiled and copyrighted in 1981. It was originally published by Cook & McDowell Publications and has not been published by them for many years. I am putting it on the internet to share the information with those of you who are interested in checking cemetery records for Sacramento County. This, as you will discover, pertains primarily to smaller cemeteries.

You will find many names from those where markers were copied and I've attempted to put names in each cemetery in alphabetical sequence (i.e., A's in A section but not necessarily in order) to make it easier to locate an individual. I would like to emphasize that my husband and I did our best to copy and transcribe information from the markers as accurately as possible but some were very difficult to read.

In addition, there may have been some typographic errors although I did my best at the time. I do, however, hope that this will prove of some assistance to you.

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Present Day Cemeteries and Memorial Parks

New Helvetia Cemetery

Captain John Sutter donated as a burial ground in December, 1849, ten acres of property located at Alhambra and J Streets which was East of the City limits and embraced the original plat of Sutter's Fort. It was known as the Sutter Fort Burying Ground

"Dental Jairus", Volume II, 1881, pages 450-456, contains the following statement: "At twenty minutes past three A.M., Wednesday, January 24th, 1846, an angel cleaved his spirit and wafted it home, in the twenty-eighth year of his age. His body was buried under a live oak tree, near a ravine about four hundred yards north east of the fort, at four o'clock P.M. same day. This was the first white corpse buried here, the Helvetia Cemetery, now within the confines of the city of Sacramento, and contains many monuments designating the last resting place of eminent personages."

According to Sacramento, California, by Hon. Win. J. Davis, published by the Lewis Publishing Company in 1890, and History of Sacramento County by G. Walter Reed, published by Historic Record Company in 1923, the first burial here was that of Major Cloud, a paymaster in the United States Army who was killed in 1847 southeast of the Fort some distance by being thrown from a horse. The second person whose remains were buried was Miss Susanna Hitchcock, who died early in 1849 at the new diggings on the Stanislaus; the third was James McDowell who was shot in Washington, just across the river. Many interments were made in 1849 and 1850, during times when sickness and cholera were so prevalent.

The grounds grew to twenty acres and in 1850 they were purchased by R. H. McDonald who was responsible for giving the cemetery its name of New Helvetia, and in 1857 J. W. Reeves purchased the property. Mr. Reeves, his wife and five children were buried in the only tomb in the Cemetery. Most graves were identified with wooden markers. Five years after the purchase by Mr. Reeves, the City purchased the Cemetery.

Golden Notes, October 1968, Volume 15, No. 1 by the Sacramento County Historical Society, reads in part on page 6: "NEW HELVETIA CEMETERY lines directly south of and in fact adjoins East Park, and in its hallowed embrace of twenty acres lies the original burial plot attached to Sutter's Fort, the gleaming beacon of the early California pioneer.

This cemetery was purchased from Sutter by Dr. R. H. McDonald and in 1857 it became the property of J. W. Reeves, now deceased. It now belongs to Mrs. Reeves and is under the care and superintendence of her father, Joseph Mellon. There may be seen near where once stood the large tree which marked the primitive burial place several headboards bearing early inscriptions. One reads: 'James McDowell. Died May 26, 1849, aged 42 years.' He came to California in 1847. The deaths of two brothers are thus related: "Thomas J. Hudspeth, a native

of Jackson county, Missouri. Died November 16th, 1849.' "B.M. Hudspith, a native of Jackson county, Missouri. Died November 16, 1850.' It will be seen that there was exactly a year between the deaths of the two brothers who quietly sleep side by side in the New Helvetia Cemetery.

In the same enclosure peacefully repose the remains of Hardin Bigelow, first Mayor of the city of Sacramento. In the squatter riots in 1850 Bigelow lost an arm, and in the fall of that year he died at the Union Hotel in San Francisco of cholera. His remains were escorted from the hotel to the steamer Senator, lying at Cunningham's wharf, by the California Light Guard and a large number of citizens, though the rain was falling in torrents. There also are disposed the bodies of Sheriff McKinney, Assessor Woodland and others who lost their lives in the squatter riots. No inscription marks their graves or gives the usual details of their deaths, but the places where they lie are designated by two large mounds to be seen just north of the center of the cemetery. These mounds are circular, having a brick coping, from which arise the cones formed of cobbles of uniform size. Mayor Bigelow's remains are under the eastern mound.

The soil in this cemetery is of superior quality, and lots there are adorned and beautified at much less labor and expense than to the City Cemetery, where there is so much sand. This city of the dead is laid out with avenues and walks and handsomely decorated with trees, shrubs, evergreens and flowers now in full bloom and beauty. For the purpose of irrigation the cemetery is supplied with one of Wilcox's water litters.

Besides the reception vault there is the family vault or tomb of the late proprietor, J. W. Reeves. It is of oval shape, with marble tombstone, and cost \$4,000. The interior of the vault, where rest his remains and those of his first wife and five children, is eleven feet deep, and is gained by a flight of ten marble steps." (this was an article in the Sacramento Union newspaper June 8, 1872, on page 8.

The Helvetia Cemetery was located on the property which is now Sutter Junior High School, 3105 I Street, Sacramento. The bodies were relocated to the Sacramento City Cemetery, St. Joseph's Cemetery, the Masonic and the I.O.O.F. and East Lawn Cemetery.

An inquiry to the Sacramento County Recorder's Office produced the following, which was the only record they have regarding the Helvetia Cemetery. "Between the dates of October 12, 1955, and March 27, 1956, all of the human remains were removed from the old Helvetia Cemetery at Alhambra Boulevard and J Streets, formerly known as the NEW HELVETIA CEMETERY. All remains which were unmarked, unidentified and unclaimed by heirs were reinterred at East Lawn Cemetery, at 43rd and Folsom Blvd., in an area containing all those designated as 'unknown'.

"All remains have identification name markers, but no claiming heirs have been reinterred at the City Cemetery, 10th and Broadway, Sacramento, California.

"Other remains having identifying markers and claimed by heirs, have been reinterred in various other cemeteries within Sacramento City and County.

"These include SYLVAN CEMETERY, at Citrus Heights; EL GROVE CEMETERY, at Elk Grove, MASONIC CEMETERY, ODD FELLOWS LAWN, SACRAMENTO MEMORIAL LAWN, CITY CEMETERY, EAST LAWN CEMETERY, ST. JOSEPH'S AND ST. MARY'S in Sacramento, California.

"Remains interred in these cemeteries are, in some cases, placed at the foot of what were already occupied graves. some are in separate graves, and some are in family plots. In two instances, remains were interred in crypts at East Lawn Cemetery.

"When the Reeves Vault (underground) at New Helvetia Cemetery was opened, on March 5, 1956, it was found to contain remains of two adults and six small children and according to old records, one small infant placed in case with the mother. Two of the caskets were iron and they carried the names of the father: John Wesley Reeves, and 18 month old Ella T. Reeves.

"Old records in these books show the following: John Wesley Reeves age 40 yrs., died Sept. 5, 1867; Rebecca Jane Reeves, (1st wife) age 30 yrs., died Feb. 18, 1863; Ella T. Reeves, age 18 mos, dtr of J. W. and Lizzie, died Feb. 18, 1866; Charlie Reeves, age 9 mo 2 days died Oct. 13, 1857; Frank L. Reeves, age 2 yrs 10 mos died Feb. 15, 1858; Delia Reeves, age 2 yr 8 mos, 17 days, died Nov. 12, 1861; Robert Tehama Reeves age 1 yr 4 mo, died Nov. 17, 1861; James Reeves, son of J. W. and Rebecca (placed in case with mother) age 8 days, died Feb. 24, 1863; Reeves infant (inf of J. W. & Lizzie, 2nd wife) died Aug. 23, 1866.

"The bodies of John Wesley Reeves and 18-month old Ella T. Reeves were in iron caskets and found to be in perfect condition. These have been buried for 90 yrs. The bodies were still a natural color and had the appearance of smooth wax. The clothing was in perfect condition also. The caskets had a small removable iron lid over the upper part of the body and a glass seal beneath this.

"These bodies and the remains of the other Reeves have all been reinterred at the City Cemetery, at 10th and Broadway, Sacramento.
June 30, 1956."

According to a newspaper report, 5,235 bodies were found and another report indicates that approximately 1,000 Chinese had been buried there. As stated in the County Recorder's letter, all bodies were relocated in other cemeteries.

Potter's Field

For those unknown or without funds, there was a Potter's Field in Sacramento. The first graveyard for the poor was in back of the Sacramento County Hospital, near the old California State Fair grounds. When it became necessary to expand the fairgrounds, the bodies were removed and placed in a new Potter's Field, adjacent to St. Mary's Cemetery. Approximately five years ago, or in the mid 1970's, the Potter's Field property became St. Mary's. All indigents who are of the Catholic faith are still buried at St. Mary's and indigents of other faiths are placed in cemeteries throughout the County.

St. Rose's Cemetery

St. Rose's Cemetery was purchased in the early 1850's. Its location was 38th and Franklin Boulevard and covered seven and one-half acres of land. Years later it was disbanded and a school built on its site. The last body was moved in 1933.

St. Joseph's Cemetery

St. Joseph's Cemetery was purchased by the St. Rose congregation and sources of information gave conflicting dates. One gave a purchase date of the summer of 1864, that it was consecrated by Bishop J. S. Alemany of San Francisco on May 7, 1865, and excavated in 1873. The other source said it was dedicated in 1856, which would indicate the purchase date was also in the 1850's. It is located on 21st and Broadway (then Y Street) and contains 10.2 acres of land. The first person interred at the Cemetery was James O'Hara of Ireland who was killed at the age of 35 years in a train explosion on April 10, 1864. There are 13,498 people interred in the Cemetery as of June, 1979.

East Lawn Cemetery

The site of the East Lawn Cemetery on Folsom Boulevard (at that time M Street Road or Schley Avenue) was originally a farm owned by Governor Newton Booth who bequested it to the mother of Booth Tarkinton. It became a burial ground in 1904 and contains at this time (1979) 44 acres of land. Many well-known people are buried in the cemetery, including William Land.

Sacramento City Cemetery

Prior to the City Cemetery, many interments had been at Buckeye Knoll, situated near W Street between 9th and 10th Streets. Ten acres for the City Cemetery was selected in December, 1849, and was located between 9th and 11th on Y Street (Broadway).

It has grown considerably in acreage, now contains some 44 acres and many groups are located in its enclosures, including the Masons, Odd Fellows, Red Men, Firemen, Printers, Pioneers, Veterans of the Mexican War, Veterans of Foreign Wars, and the State. A plaque at the entry to the cemetery reads:

"Sacramento City Cemetery. Resting place of California pioneers, this cemetery was established in 1850. Many of the victims of the cholera epidemic of that year are buried here. Included among the graves of illustrious Californians are those of Governors John Bigler, Newton Booth and William Irwin; General George Wright, hero of the Mexican War; Mark Hopkins, co-builder of the Central Pacific Railroad; General Albert M. Winn, founder of the Native Sons of the Golden West; Hardin Bigelow, first mayor of Sacramento; William S. Hamilton, son of Alexander Hamilton, E. B. Crocker, founder of the Crocker Art Gallery; and Rev. O. C. Wheeler, organizer in 1850 of the First Baptist Church."

Also near the entrance is a monument which reads:

"JOHN A. SUTTER, JR. 1826-1897. Founder and planner of the City of Sacramento 1848. Died in Acapulco, Mexico. American Consul for 24 years. Reinterred in Sacramento with his only surviving daughter, Anna Sutter Young. Born Acapulco September 18, 1888. Died San Francisco January 24, 1970."

The earliest marker in the Cemetery is that of Franklin B. Davis who died in 1846. Markers bearing dates earlier than 1850 indicates that bodies were probably moved from other burial grounds. At the rear of the cemetery is a monument which is the only identification to the 600 people who died during the cholera epidemic in Sacramento in the early 1850's. The cemetery contains approximately 35,000 graves. (1979).

Jewish (or Hebrew) Cemetery

In 1850 the first Jewish Cemetery was established. It was under the control of the Congregation B'nai Israel but owned by the Sacramento Hebrew Benevolent Society. It contained 160 square feet and extended one block east on 31st Street on the south side of J Street which was then the eastern boundary line of the City.

Golden Notes, October, 1968, Volume 15, No. 1 by Sacramento County Historical Society, reads in part: "...In 1860 the cemetery was inclosed by a handsome wooden fence, at an expense of \$1,000, but it was swept away by the floods of 1861-62. After the waters had subsided the cemetery was laid out in lots and walks and tastily ornamented with evergreens, shrubs and flowers. It is now surrounded by a brick wall four feet high, on which is a wooden fence three or four feet high, both costing \$2,400. In the inclosure is a chapel erected at an expense of \$500. Sacramento Union, June 8, 1872, page 8, columns 6-7." In 1923, all bodies were moved and placed in the newer Jewish Cemetery on Stockton Boulevard, Home of Peace.

Brighton Burials

The Sacramento Union, June 3, 1867, page 3, column 1 contains the following article:

"Skeletons – Coroner Conbois has given us the following explanation in reference to the skeletons exposed on the river bank at Brighton. The place where the remains are now exposed was formerly used as a burial place by the residents of the neighborhood. No bodies have been buried there for several years. At the time it was first used (1850) the river was a quarter of a mile off, but has been gradually encroaching on and washing away the bank, until now it flows through the ground once used as the burial place of the dead. At the time of the squatter riots, which took place at the Allen ranch in 1850, the adopted son of Mrs. Allen was shot and killed. The shock was too much for Mrs. Allen who died the following day. They were buried side by side. Mr. Lewis, who afterwards lived on the ranch as a tenant, died there and was buried near Mrs. Allen and her son. There was also a colored man who worked for Colonel Kipp (who lived there after the Allens) who was accidentally drowned while watering a horse, buried near the same place. The Coroner hopes that persons making reports to the newspapers in the future would be a little more particular in stating the facts as he does not consider it his duty to visit all the old burial grounds in the county to examine or remove the skeletons that may be there discovered."

Thompson and West's History of Sacramento County, California, published 1880 shows James Allen settled with his family on the American River (Brighton Township). He was driven out during squatters' riots, an adopted son of his being killed during the riots. Allen afterwards returned and took possession of the land. He sold out and moved about 18 years prior to the aforementioned book. A Kipp and Charles Petit settled on the Allen place in 1851 but when Allen returned, they gave possession.

SYLVAN CEMETERY
(Citrus Heights)

According to "Walking...From Sylvan to Citrus Heights 1860-1960" by Roeley E. Guisti, the community of Sylvan was named by William Thomas, the proprietor of the 14 and 15 Mile House, which were freighter stops on the way to the gold country. The Cemetery land was donated by Daniel Lewis in 1862 and at that time consisted of only 1/10th of an acre. The first grave was that of James Horton, buried September 1864. He was a young man from Tennessee who suffered from an eye ailment and fearing blindness, took poison and died. The Cemetery District was formed in 1926.

The marker information for the Sylvan Cemetery has been compiled by Isabella Sullivan and printed in Genealogical Research News, Vol. 8. The 18 acre Cemetery is located on Auburn Boulevard in Citrus Heights.

George Wilson Cemetery

The George Wilson Cemetery is located on the family ranch south of Highway 50 near Folsom. It contains 1/16th of an acre and is for family members only.

Sunset Hill Cemetery

The Sunset Hill Cemetery was located south of the City Cemetery. The ground was purchased for burial grounds in 1869 by Joseph A. Conboie. I could find no further information on this Cemetery, however, one of Sacramento's coroners was a Mr. Conoboie and I would assume that the Sunset Hill Cemetery became a part of the City Cemetery.

Sloughhouse Cemetery

The Sloughhouse Cemetery is located on Meiss Road off the Jackson Highway but because of vandalism, it is now fenced and locked.

In 1845 the Thomas Rhoads family left Missouri with the Donner party. Splitting from the ill-fated party on their guide's advice, the family arrived at Sutter's Fort in 1846, making them possibly the first Mormons to travel West. With news that the Donner party was stranded, two Rhoads boys, John and Daniel, were among the first rescue party to reach them.

The Cemetery was started by Catherine Rhoads Daylor, one of the fourteen children of Thomas and Elizabeth Rhoads, in 1850. In 1847, Catherine married William Daylor of London, England. When he died of cholera October 30, 1850, Mrs. Daylor set aside five acres of property in Sloughhouse for a cemetery. She married again, to W. R. Grimshaw, who was a native of New York, and had opened a store and trading post in partnership with William Daylor in 1849. Mr. Daylor's friend, Jared Sheldon (born Underhill, Vermont in 1813) came to California in 1832.

He married Sarah Rhoads, sister of Catherine Daylor. His murder made headlines in the July 14, 1851, Sacramento Union newspaper. Both he and his wife are buried in the Cemetery.

There are some two hundred graves located in the Sloughhouse Cemetery.

The property was owned in recent years by Percy Westerberg, a descendant of a sister of Mrs. Daylor, who deeded it to the Daughters of the Utah Pioneers, who have undertaken the Cemetery's restoration.

Meadowview Cemetery

The July 29, 1979, issue of the Sacramento Union carried an article on page B-1 regarding the sale of land located on the northwest corner of Meadowview Road and 24th Street. Under State law, six or more bodies buried in one place constitutes a cemetery and from the article, at least six bodies were buried on the 1.75 acres, although the above-ground traces have disappeared. The article relates to the ownership of the land and indicates that rumors were that some American Indians were buried there.

Eagles and Knights of Pythias Cemetery

This small cemetery is located on Natoma and Sibley Streets in Folsom and is across the street from the Catholic Cemetery. (Copied April, 1974)

Elder Creek Cemetery

The Elder Creek Cemetery, established 1864, is located on Elder Creek Road between 65th Expressway and Power Inn Road. It contains two acres of land which are enclosed with a wire fence. It is well laid out with most plots being built up. Almost all markers are intact, with less than a half dozen being broken, although there are a number of wooden ones and several are marked "unknown." This cemetery, as does some of the others, has many beautiful trees and shrubbery. There are flowering vines and bushes covering a few plots and it appears to be well maintained. (Copied July 1979)

Hicksville Cemetery

Of all the smaller cemeteries in Sacramento that I've visited, the four acre Hicksville Cemetery on Arno Road, just off Highway 99 in Galt was the best kept in my opinion. A wire fence enclosed the cemetery and its green lawn was closely cropped. Various types of trees (including pines and a majestic eucalyptus, dotted the grounds, enhancing its beauty. Matthew Kilgore Cemetery

Thompson and West's History of Sacramento, California (1880) contains a brief biography on Mathew Kilgore. He was born in 1801 in Ohio and lived there until 1827. He moved to Indiana, then to Lee County, Iowa, where he was a supervisor for three years. He moved to Santa Clara County (CA) in 1853 and Sacramento County in 1855. From 1858 through 1864, he lived in Yolo County, then back to Sacramento County. He lived fifteen miles from Sacramento on the Placerville Road and owned 154 acres of land. He married Masa McGuire of Ohio in 1822 and they had five sons and three daughters. Three sons, two daughters and his wife had all died prior to publication of the above referenced book, Mrs. Kilgore having died April 8, 1875.

The Matthew Kilgore Cemetery was purchased in May, 1874, incorporated March, 1888, and situated 14 miles east of Sacramento on the Folsom Highway, the description at that time.

The cemetery is small, located east of Rancho Cordova on Kilgore Road, and is well laid out. Its road is paved and goes in a U shape, with graves on the sides and in the middle. It has an iron fence at the entrance but the gates are gone. At the time the information was copied (June 1979) its condition was not good. There were beer cans, broken bottles and litter strewn about. Plots were overgrown with thistles and weeds and there were burrows and holes made by moles, gophers or other rodents. Vandals had caused considerable damage, breaking and destroying old markers. At one time, it undoubtedly was a beautiful cemetery. Most plots are raised. A variety of trees surround the area with eucalyptus being the predominant.

Mormon Island Cemetery

Mormon Island Cemetery is located on the Green Valley Road outside of Folsom. It is just within El Dorado County, but only a few feet from the Sacramento County line. The Cemetery is off the road and is fenced and locked and the key must be obtained at the General Store on Green Valley Road.

The historical marker on Green Valley Road reads as follows: "Mormon Island, Negro Hill, Salmon Falls, and Condemned Bar. These historic mining towns, and other mining camps of the gold rush era, now inundated by Folsom Lake, are commemorated by the Mormon Island Memorial Cemetery nearby. Here were reburied the pioneers whose graves were flooded, when the lake was formed by Folsom Dam. Their memory is a reminder that what we are today we owe to those who came before us.
