Membership Application

The San Diego Genealogical Society is an all-volunteer, non-profit organization founded in 1946. Its purpose is to promote general interest in the fields of genealogy and family history. The Society maintains an extensive genealogical research library, distributes a genealogical newsletter, conducts educational programs and sponsors regular seminars and genealogy research trips.

MEMBERSHIP: To join, applicants should attend at least one meeting, complete the membership application below and submit a 4-generation ancestor chart. Membership includes the Society's Newsletter, SDGS Yearbook, classes and unlimited Library access.

LIBRARY: The Society's Library is located at 7343 Ronson Road, Suite O, San Diego, CA 92111. The specialized genealogical research collection includes more than 11,000 books, CDs, microform records and genealogy periodicals. The library is regularly staffed by a librarian and volunteers to help members with their genealogical research.

PUBLICATIONS:

The *San Diego Genealogical Society Newsletter* is distributed monthly (except January) to all current members. The Newsletter contains information on upcoming programs, speakers, seminars, fund-raising events, special projects, library acquisitions, member research queries and other items of current interest to genealogists.

The Society *Yearbook* contains information about the Board of Directors, Society Committees, past presidents, publications, By-laws, meeting dates and the names and addresses of members. The yearbook and membership card are distributed annually.

San Diego Leaves & Saplings, the major research publication of the Society, contains records of genealogical and historical significance for San Diego County, California. *San Diego Leaves & Saplings* has been published quarterly since 1972. The subscription rate is \$20 per year for members and \$24 for non-members. Back issues may be purchased for \$7.50 each.

MEETINGS: The Society meets monthly on the second Saturday of the month, except in December, at St. Andrews Lutheran Church, 8350 Lake Murray Blvd. (at the corner of Jackson Drive), San Diego, CA. Meetings begin at noon and include two presentations on topics of interest to genealogists and family historians of all levels. Each presentation typically lasts about 50 minutes with a refreshment break between them. Meetings are open to the public. Beginners are always welcome.
