

PASSING THE HALF-MILLION MILESTONE ...

Starting from small pioneer settlements with barely 4,000 residents, the Treasure Coast has grown exponentially in the last 100 years. Led by Port St. Lucie's soaring population growth, the number of residents in the region has rocketed past the 500,000 mark.

... WITH MANY MORE ON THE WAY

Over the next quarter century, the population of the Treasure Coast will continue to surge.

Projections show that the Treasure Coast could have anywhere from 690,000 to just over 1 million residents by 2030.

According to the Treasure Coast Regional Planning Council, even with 1 million individuals calling the region home, the Treasure Coast as a whole would be a long way from reaching the point where the population becomes unmanageable for its residents to enjoy a quality lifestyle.
