RET ABEEL New York - S28210

Services: Garret Abeel of Catskill, District of Cossackie, Albany Co., N.Y. , a merchant, served as a private in Capt. William Snider's Co., Regiment of Albany Co. militia commanded by Anthony VanBurgen.

Pension: Received pension New York at \$48.00 per year, 20 Sep. 1786. Inscribed on the roll of New York at the rate of \$6.40 per month. Formal Certificate issued 13 Apr. 1824.

Residence: In 1824, Garret Abeel was a resident of Catskill, Green Co., N.Y.

DAVID ABEL Connecticut - S10314

Service: Enlisted in February 1776 for 3 months serving under Capt. Benj. Wright of Vermont. He then served as a pvt. under Col. Warner's Reg't. for 9 months in the Continental Line of Connecticut.

Pension: Inscribed on the rolls of New York at the rate of \$30.00 per year. Certificate issued 23 October 1833.

Birth: In Lebanon, Litchfield Co., Conn. In 1750

Residence: On 21 Sept. 1832 in Pike, Allegany Co., N.Y. At the time of enlistment in Sharon, Litchfield Co., Conn.

WILLIAM ABEL Connecticut - W20559

Service: As a private in Col. Hinman's Regiment, of the (Connecticut) Continental Line for 2 years. Enlisted for 9 months at Sharon, Conn. In April 1775. Enlisted for 9 months at Sharon, Conn. In fall of 1776.

Pension: Inscribed on the roll of Connecticut for \$80.00 per year. Certificate issued 20 Oct. 1834.

Birth: 14 January 1749 in Sharon, Connecticut.

Death: William died 17 March 1837 in the town of Kiltry, province of Upper Canada (age 88 years).

Marriage: William Abel to Lois Merry in New Canaan, N.Y. by Samuel Camp, a presbyterian minister, 15 April 1786. She was a resident of Pittsfield, Mass.

Declarations: John Merry of Booneville, Oneida Co., and a sister to the deponent, Lois Abel, state that Mr. Abel arrived in Jefferson Co., N.Y. in Feb. 1835 from Sharon, Conn. On 16 April 1833. Willim Abel of Adams, Jefferson Co., N.Y. was aged 84 years. On the 5 March 1839, Lois Abell, late a resident of the town of Bastard in the Province of Upper Canada Was aged 73 years.

Family: 5 March 1839, Lyman Abel will be 46 on 14 March Inst. 5 March 1839, Melinda Abel, eldest, wife of Joshua Williams of Jefferson Co., N.Y. Is about 52 years old 2 September last.

Children: Melinda Abel Williams, Lyman Abel, Freeman Abel, Elizabeth Ragon, Sally Abel, John Abel, Heman Abel, David Abel, Lydia Durfy. These children left at time of Lois Abel's death on 6 August 1848, Booneville, Oneida Co., New York.

THOMAS ABEL Vermont - R8

Pension: Widow, Eunice, applied for pension in 1837 - Captain Thomas Abell. Claims rejected. Name not on the rolls. Lack of proof.

Births: Thomas Abell b. Norwich, Conn. 21 Oct. 1749. Eunice Griswold, b. 1752

Death: Thomas Abel died Pomfret, Chautauqua Co., New York 14 October 1814.

Marriage: Norwich Conn. By Rev. Mr. Ellis, a Presbyterian Clergy - April 1771 - in home of Mr. Ebenezer Griswold.
