Mr. Mark M. Lambert and Miss Laura Virginia Hall were united in marriage at the Methodist Episcopal Church in Harrisville, Ritchie County, West Virginia, on July 5, 1881.

The following children were born unto this union:

Mabel, born July 26, 1882; and died April 6, 1903

Clarence Bernard, born October 22nd, 1883; (died 1947)

Ada, born August 25, 1886; and died February 15, 1890

Fred Lee, born July 26, 1888; (died)

Frank Ray, born August, 1889, and died January 5, 1890

Harry Paul, born November 30, 1890; and died Nov. 1960

Mark M. Lambert, the groom, was born in September 1839; and died May 7, 1914, he being the son of **Isaac** and **Sarah Lambert** of Ellenboro, W. Va., formerly of Frederick County, Virginia.

Laura Virginia Hall, the bride, was born in Harrisville, W.Va., December 18th 1859, she being the daughter of **Smith C. Hall** and **Virginia Scott Hall**.

The names of the brothers and sisters of the late **M. M. Lambert**, (all dead) are as follows: **Madison**, and **George Washington Lambert**, full brothers; **Catharine Lynch**, wife of **Hiram Lynch**, of Harrison County, and **Ann Maxwell**, wife of **James Maxwell** of Doddridge County, W.Va.; **Joseph Lambert**, who passed away many years ago at Harrisville, and Miss **Elizabeth Lambert**, dying in 1884, were half brothers and half sister of the aforementioned groom.

Wm. Hall and **Mary Ann Lowther Hall**, the paternal grandparents of the aforesaid bride, were married about the year 1813, their first child having been born December 20, 1814. The following sons and daughters were born unto this couple: **Jesse Lowther Hall**, **Lemuel Hall**, **Wm. Hall**, **Cyrus Hall**, **Hannibal Hall**, **Elias Hall**, **Smith C. Hall**, **Lucinda (Lowther) Hall**, **Mary (Broadhurst) Hall**, **Celina (Monroe) Hall**, **Elizabeth (McKinley) Hall**, and one young daughter (don't remember name) bathing her feet in cold water, causing her death.
