Craig Roberts Scott, M.A., CGSM

Mr. Scott is the author of *The 'Lost Pensions': Settled Accounts of the Act of 6 April 1838* and *Records of the Accounting Officers of the Department of the Treasury, Inventory 14 (Revised)*. He is the President & CEO of Heritage Books, Inc., a genealogical publishing firm with over 4,000 titles in print located in Westminster, Maryland. A professional genealogist and historical researcher for more than twenty-four years, he specializes in the records of the National Archives and Records Administration (NARA), especially those that relate to the military. He is a member of the Company of Military Historians, recently a Governor-at-Large of the Virginia Genealogical Society, on the editorial board of the National Genealogical Society Quarterly, and recently a Director of the Association of Professional Genealogists. Mr. Scott is a faculty member of the Institute of Genealogy and Historical Research and is the Coordinator of the Advanced Military Records Course. He was awarded the Grahame T.
