Resthaven

Resthaven is located at: is located at 34°7'57" North, 83°58'32" West (34.132396, -83.975455).

The town of Rest Haven was incorporated by an act of the General Assembly in 1938.

Its limits are described as follows in the town's charter:

"Beginning at the present line of the city limits of the City of Buford at the intersection of the new Buford and Atlanta highway with the old Buford and Gainesville road, thence extending north along said Buford and Gainesville highway in the direction of Gainesville, Georgia, to the Hall County line, and shall embrace the territory included from the center of the pavement of said road for a distance of one fourth of a mile on each side of the highway."

The town of Rest Haven had a population of 91 in 1940. The census of 1950 shows that the population had increased to 147, a gain of 60 per cent.

As of 2000 the census shows: 151 people, 57 households, and 42 families residing in the town.
