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Abt 1773

A **Abraham LEMMON** born in Green Co., Kentucky to John LEMMON and Elizabeth MICKEY. (note from JTR: Green Co., KY wasn't created until 1792)

1775-1780

Rudien LEMONS/LEMMONS born, he married Elizabeth HIESTAND in Green Co. Kentucky, he died 1846 in Hart Co., Kentucky. One known child, Rudien LEMMON, was born on 26 Oct 1801 and died 30 May 1868 in Lima, Adams Co., Illinois. He married Sarah (last name unknown)

9 Aug 1787

Birth of **Anna LEMONS** in South Carolina to Abraham LEMONS, who was identified as her father when she was married in 1812 to **Andrew BILYEU** in Hardin Co., Kentucky. Her birthplace shown on 1850 and 1860 Federal Census from Miller Co., Missouri.

Abt 1790

Birth of **Elizabeth LEMONS** in South Carolina probably to Abraham LEMONS, who signed his consent when she was married in 1811 to **John McCUBBIN** in Hardin Co., Kentucky. Her birthplace shown on 1850 and 1860 Federal Census from Miller Co., Missouri.

1791

Birth of **Jacob LEMONS** to Abraham and Barbara LEMMONS of Green Co. (now Taylor Co.), Kentucky. He married **Catherine HARRIS** in 1820 and they had 4 children. She died in 1829. He then married Ann W. SCHOOLER and they had 10 children. He died 12 May 1855 in Pike Co., Missouri.

1792

Kentucky became a state. Early land records are kept by county clerk of Jefferson Co., KY and are called "Land Entry Book No. A"

April 1794

Harrison Co., Kentucky Order Book A – **Jas. LEMMON and wife, Amelia**, of Scott Co., Kentucky to Jno. Kinkade of Harrison, land located in Harrison Co., Kentucky. Source: Kentucky Court and Other Records Vol. II, 1972, Genealogical Publishing Co., Compiled by Mrs. William Breckenridge Ardery

1796

John (X his mark) LEMMONS of Green Co., KY may be the John (X) Lemmon/Laymon/Leamon in the Washington Co., TN, who sold out land there in 1795, and John (X) Lemmons shows up in 1796 in Green Co., KY, 800 acres in "Lemmons Bend" of the Green River of Taylor Co. (formed from Green Co.)

26 Feb 1797

Marriage of William ELLIOTT and Susannah BRUNK. Surety, John LEMMON. Consent is signed by John BRUNK, but no relationship is shown. Bond dated February 26, 1797. Married February, 1798, by Josiah Dodge. The register shows the bride as Susannah BURK. Note discrepancy in dates. 24 Aug 1801

27 Sep 1803

Isaac LEMONS born somewhere in Kentucky, probably in Hardin Co. to Abraham LEMONS Sr.

1819-1850

Abraham LEMMONS was listed on page 213 out of 297 pages of the Index to Will Book A, Hart Co., Kentucky. The Hart Co., Kentucky Courthouse burned in 1928. This has caused a severe hardship on anyone researching their families in Hart Co., Kentucky. The index is all that exists of Will Book A. The index apparently escaped the fire. It was compiled by Colonel Ben LeBree and was originally published by the Hart Co. Historical Society in their quarterly publication.

Marriage of **John McCUBBIN** and **Betsy LEMMON** in Hardin Co., Kentucky. Surety, William Elliot. Consent signed by Abraham LAMAN (sic) with no relationship shown. Bond dated December 31, 1810, married January 3, 1811, by Thos. Whitman.

Anna PRUITT (Prewitt) born in Virginia. She married **Isaac LEMONS** who was born in Kentucky.

Private **Abraham LEMONS** served in Adams' Regiment, Ohio Militia, Roll Box 124, Roll Exct 602

Note from Norma Karter: the marriage record reads: Abraham Lemmons and Sary Melton surety issued November 1, 1815. Surety by James Melton. However, in the

body of the bond it states that James Melton is the groom. I'm assuming that Abraham was the surety and they confused the groom and the father. The marriage record shows no bond (probably because of the error). It reads James Melton and Sarah Lemmon married November 5, 1815.

23 Aug 1820 – **Abraham LEMMONS** Deed – 100 Acres in Hardin Co., Kentucky Gabriel Slaughter, Esq., Lieutenant Governor and acting Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky to all these presents shall come Greeting. Know ye that

by virtue and in consideration of Kentucky Land Office Warrant No. 2419, there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto Abraham Lemmons a certain tract or parcel of land containing one-hundred acres by survey bearing date the sixth day of July, one-thousand, eight-hundred and eighteen, lying and being in the county of Hardin near to Green River and boundaries followeth to wit "Beginning at a white oak in the hollow above the head of a large falling spring, running thence south seventy-six, east ninety poles to a red oak, thence east thirty-three poles on the west side of a hollow thence north thirteen, east ninety-five poles to a hickory and ash on the south side of a small knob, thence with the meanders of the same south seventy-five, west forty-eight poles to a post oak, north forty, west eighteen poles to a post oak, north thirteen, east twenty-six poles to two spanish oaks and pin oak. North fifty-five, east thirty-eight poles to a red oak, two black walnuts and hickory on the north side of said knob and corner to Thomas Whitman's land, thence with a line of the same north eighteen, east sixty poles to a stake in the barrens, thence off north seventy-eight, west sixty poles to a stake in the barrens, thence south seventy-two, west two hundred poles to the beginning. With it, appurtenances to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with its appurtenances to the said Abraham Lemmons and his heirs forever. In witness whereof the said Gabriel Slaughter, Esq., Lieutenant Governor of the Commonwealth of Kentucky hath hereunto set his hand and caused the seal of the said Commonwealth to be affixed at Frankfort on the fifteenth day of June in the year of our Lord one-thousand, eight hundred and nineteen and of the Commonwealth the twenty-eight.

Article First – I direct the payment of all my just debts and funeral expenses.

Article Second – I give to my youngest son, Lester A. Lemons, my entire farm being the N-1/2 of the SE 1/4 and the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 13 Township 30, Range 16, containing 120 acres.

I want my wife, Rebecca A. Lemons, to have a living off of the farm and make her home on the farm as long as she remains my widow and I give her my two mares, one gray and one bay, nine years old each. I value the mares at \$150 each. And I give her two milk cows and I give her all the hogs that is on the farm and my wagon and harness and buggy and harness and all my farming tools.

I give to my son, James T. Lemons, one thousand (1,000) dollars. And I give to my son, Wm. E. Lemons, one thousand (1,000) dollars. Said two thousand dollars will be paid with the remainder of the stock on the place and with the money and notes that I have on hand and if there is a remainder after James T. and Wm. E. gets their \$1000, each said remainder shall go to Rebecca E. Lemons, my wife.

History of the Lemmon Family

James, John, and Robert Lemmon

Robert Lemmon with brothers John and James emigrated to America from Ireland in 1750, settling in Baltimore, Maryland. They remained there for a number of years agitating the question in favor of American liberty and when wars came they were in the front lines and the heat of battle. Robert Lemmon and his brothers entered the army during the French and Indian War, and served under General Edward Braddock and his Aide de Camp, George Washington. They were in the Battle of Fort Duquesne on July 9th, 1755, on the occasion of defeat and mortal wounding of General Braddock. At the outbreak of the American Revolution the three brothers again

entered the services of their country--this time as Captains in the Maryland and Virginia lines. Captain James Lemmon was killed in the Battle of Brandywine. Captain John Lemmon survived and upon the termination of hostilities moved with his family to Green County, Kentucky, was known as Nelson Co., until 1792, where he settled on and improved a fine farm upon the banks of the Green River--known far and wide as "Lemmons's Bend." He reared a large family, the greater portion of whom subsequently became pioneers in the new States and territories. His great-grandson, Major Alexander C. Lemmon, settled in Dallas, Texas in 1869 and it is for him that Lemmon Avenue in Dallas is named. After serving in the French and Indian War, Robert Lemmon was married to Eleanor Davis--born in Wales and of the Jefferson Davis lines. In 1786 they moved to Kentucky and settled at Elk Creek, in Shelby County, and he died there after 1800.
