INTRODUCTION

The Provincial Archives of New Brunswick was established in 1967 as the repository for the records of the Province. It also collects private records in all media, including maps, architectural plans, photographs, motion picture films and videos, sound recordings, microfilms, and published material.

This guide is designed for family and local historians who wish to use Provincial Archives sources during a visit to the institution as well as through their local libraries. Many of the Charlotte County records of particular value to the family historian have been microfilmed and are available on interlibrary loan. Your local library may order one to three microfilms at a time.

It should be emphasized that many government documents have not been microfilmed and must be used at the Archives. Also, most of the more than 2,000 private manuscript collections have not been filmed and must be used in person. This includes material in the **Family Histories Collection (MC1)** and in the **New Brunswick Publications Collection (MC80)**.

When New Brunswick was established in 1784 it was divided into eight counties. As the population grew the original counties were divided and new counties set up; the final complement is 15. These counties are subdivided into civil parishes similar to American townships.

Charlotte County is one of the original counties established in 1785. It is located in southwestern New Brunswick. To the south lies the Bay of Fundy; to the west, the State of Maine. It is bounded on the north and east by the counties of York, Sunbury, Queens, Kings, and Saint John. Seven parishes, **Pennfield, Saint Andrews, Saint David, Saint George, Saint Patrick, Saint Stephen** and **West Isles** were created in 1786. **Campobello** and **Grand Manan** were set off from West Isles in 1803 and 1816 respectively. In 1823, **Saint James** was created from Saint Stephen. **Dumbarton** was set off from Saint Patrick in 1856, and **Lepreau** was created from Pennfield in 1859. **Clarendon** was set off from Pennfield and Lepreau in 1869. **Dufferin** was set off from St. Stephen in 1873; **Saint Croix** was created from Saint Andrews in 1874.

1. CENSUS RETURNS

Census records for the years 1851, 1861, 1871, 1881, 1891 and 1901 are available for most Charlotte County parishes. The records contain names, ages, relationships, occupations, and religion. They **may** also include racial origins, entry date into the colony and other data. Unindexed and unalphabetized microfilmed copies of the census data can be used at the Provincial Archives or borrowed on interlibrary loan from the National Archives of Canada, 395 Wellington Street, Ottawa, ON, K1A 0N3. **Census microfilm cannot be borrowed from the Provincial Archives in Fredericton.**

2. MARRIAGE RECORDS (RS148)

Marriage Registers contain information from marriage certificates filed with the registrar. They list the names of the bride and groom, their respective residences, and the names of officiating clergy and witnesses. **Entries do not give the parents' names.**

Researchers should also check microfilm **F6717** for marriage licenses issued by George S. Hill, a local justice, between 1851 and 1921.

3. MARRIAGE BONDS (RS551A)

Marriage Bonds, known administratively as *Performance Bonds*, were required when banns were not read or the clergyman did not know both parties. They include the names of the bride and groom and the name of the groom's bondsman. Rarely are the names of parents given. This series of documents, covering the entire province for the period 1810 to 1932, is incomplete. County marriage registers should be consulted first. Then the index listed below should be consulted before borrowing the bonds on film.

4. VITAL STATISTICS BRANCH RECORDS (RS141)

Microfilm copies of birth records for 1801 to 1899 and marriage and death records for 1888 to 1919 are available at the Archives. Birth records from 1900 to the present, and marriage and death records from 1920 to the present, can be obtained from: Vital Statistics Branch, Department of Health and Community Services, PO Box 6000, Fredericton, NB, E3B 5H1. The fee is \$15 for a search of a three-year period; a certificate will be issued if data is found. The microfilms listed in the following sections are available on interlibrary loan from the Provincial Archives. Please note that pre-1920 vital statistics are incomplete. For that period, church and other genealogical records **may** provide missing information.

4A. BIRTHS

4A1a. LATE REGISTRATIONS OF BIRTHS: CARDS (1810-1899)

After 1888, some individuals born as early as 1810 requested that their births be registered for legal or personal reasons. Some 25,000 entries on cards have been arranged in alphabetical order by the individual's name and have been microfilmed. Data on the cards **may** include name, place and date of birth, names of parents, parents' ages, residence and place of birth, racial origin, and occupation. The card series should be examined before the documents in Section **4A1b**.

5. CUSTOMS HOUSE ADMINISTRATION RECORDS (RS23, PASSENGER LISTS)

A small number of passenger lists for immigrant ships coming to the province in 1816, 1833, 1834, 1837 and 1838 have survived. **The records are available on microfilms F9798 and F9799. The index of passengers and crews, microfilm F17834**, contains about 10,000 names. The ship crews are included because some immigrants worked their passage as seamen. Each entry gives a passenger's surname and given name, passenger number, name of the ship and an archival reference number.

NOTE: *Passengers to New Brunswick: The Customs House Records; 1833, 1834, 1837, 1838*, (MC80/1263), is available at the Provincial Archives.

6. LAND RECORDS

6A1. LAND PETITIONS (RS108)

These are requests submitted to government by those seeking land grants. The records cover the years from 1783 to 1918 and provide the name, age, origin, marital status, number of children, and location and amount of land requested. Additional biographical data is sometimes provided. An index of some 67,000 names on film **F13763** can be borrowed on interlibrary loan. **Please note** that many people petitioned as a group. In such cases the land petition is filed under the name of the first petitioner. The index provides the name of each petitioner, county, date, and film number for ordering the correct microfilm on interlibrary loan.

6A2. LAND PETITIONS: CURRENT SERIES (RS272)

These petitions cover the years from 1832 to 1966. The series is "Current" in that the Department of Natural Resources and Energy continues to add to it. The documents contain very little biographical data. A card index for the years 1832 to 1867 is available at the Archives. **A microfilmed index for the years 1868-1966 on film F12524** can be borrowed on interlibrary loan. Both series should be checked; there may be more than one petition from an individual.

6B. LAND GRANTS (RS686)

The land grant books form the official land records kept by the New Brunswick government. Beginning in 1784 those who had been granted land under the Nova Scotia government between 1765 and 1784 were required to re-register their grants in New Brunswick. The land grant documents cover the years 1784 to 1986 and describe the metes and bounds of granted lands. **The name of the grantee is provided but no other biographical information such as the name of wife, children, or birth place is given in this record series.** An index to these land grants is available on microfiche for interlibrary loan.

6C. REGISTRY OFFICE RECORDS (RS86)

These records cover the years 1784 to 1974 and include copies of deeds, leases, mortgages, liens and other land transactions. A number of wills (those which transfer title of land) are also found in this series. There is a multi-reel grantor-grantee index at the Archives. Registry Office records are not available on interlibrary loan. **Staff at the Provincial Archives can neither research nor do extensive photocopying of these records on behalf of patrons.**
