Information on Daniel Boone's residence and movement through your county.

Information on Rebecca Bryan's family. She is the grand-daughter of Morgan & Martha (Strode) Bryan, Sr., the first European family to settle in the Yadkin Valley in 1748. They brought enslaved people with them. They lived in a place near the Shallow Ford called the Bryan Settlement. A few Indians/First Americans still lived in the area.
