Directions to GSNJ Annual Meeting

From New Jersey Turnpike (North or South) Exit 9 or Route 1 (North or South)

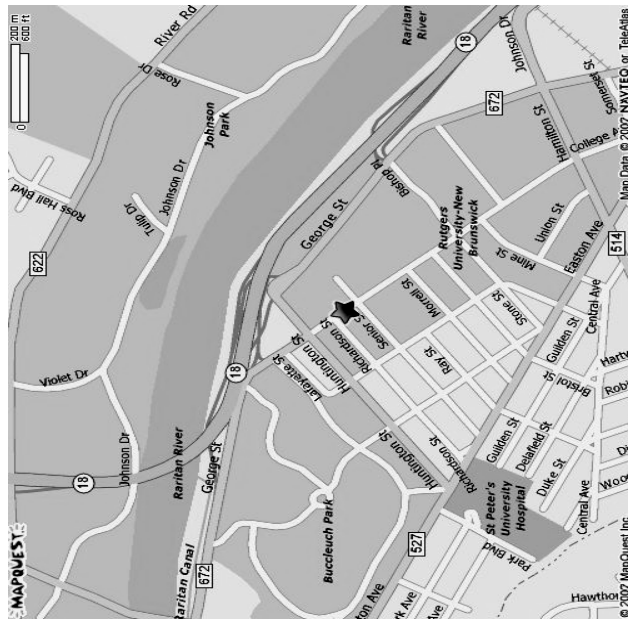
Take Exit 9, bear right after the tollbooths, and follow the signs for "Route 18 North - New Brunswick." Stay left to continue on Route 18 North. Stay on Route 18 North past the two exits for Route 27 and take the exit marked "George Street - Rutgers University" (approximately 2.6 miles from the Turnpike). (NOTE: DO NOT attempt to take the first George Street exit, immediately after Paulus Blvd, which is now closed.) At the top of the exit ramp, turn right onto George Street. Continue along George Street and bear left at the jug handle onto Huntington Street. Continue along Huntington Street for one block. Turn left at the first traffic light onto College Avenue. The Archibald Stevens Alexander Library will be on the left hand side.

From Route 287 (North or South)

Take Exit 9 "River Road, Bound Brook, Highland Park." Proceed East on River Road toward Highland Park. Make a right onto Route 18 South (exit after the traffic light at Landing Lane). Cross the Raritan River on the John Lynch Memorial Bridge. Stay in the right lane and take the exit marked "George Street - Rutgers University, New Brunswick, Route 27." Turn right at the first traffic light onto Huntington Street. Continue along Huntington Street for one block. At the traffic light, turn left on College Avenue. The Archibald Stevens Alexander Library will be on the left hand side.

Parking: Free street parking at meters is available on Saturday. Additional parking is available in the College Avenue Parking Deck adjacent to Alexander Library; see our website <www.gsnj.org> for further information.
