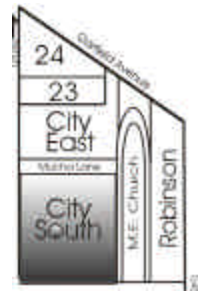


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY – City South Section

This section is in the southeast part of the cemetery. If you enter at the Garfield Gate this section is adjacent to Section 3/City North between it and Section 2. Alternate rows were read north to south, then south to north, starting at the eastern edge by Mucha Lane. Note that some rows do not have any new entries after 1900. Inscriptions were read by Gladys Reynolds and Pat Russell and transcribed by Pat Russell in 2001.
