

GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Evergreen – Division 1

The southwest corner of Greenlawn Cemetery is labeled Evergreen on the cemetery maps. Because of its large size and areas broken by paths, it has been divided into four divisions. Division one is just inside the Offner St. entrance to the right. It stretches southward to the first unpaved pathway which divides it from Division 2. It ends on the east where it meets Soldier's Circle. All rows were read north to south, starting in the northwest corner. Inscriptions were read several years ago by Betsy DeMent and updated by Gladys Reynolds and Pat Russell in November 2001.
