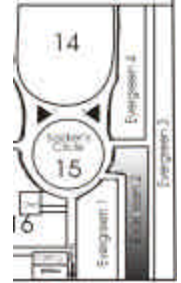


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Evergreen – Division 2

This division of Evergreen lies east/west between two unpaved driveways and north/south between Division 1 and Division 3. It is elongated on the north to meet Soldier's Circle, and ends at another unpaved pathway which meets the road around Soldier's Circle. As in Division 1, all rows are read from north to south beginning at the northwest corner. Read by Betsy DeMent in 1995 and updated by Gladys Reynolds and Pat Russell in 2002.
