

GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Evergreen – Division 3

This division of Evergreen is at the southern edge of the cemetery bordered on the south by Grant St. It is between the Grant St. Gate auto road on the east and the Offnere Street fence on the west. The north border is the first alley to the left after entering the Grant St. gate. The reading starts at the southeast corner by the Grant St. gate and proceeds south to north with the first row, and reverses, north to south, alternating row to row. This was read in 2002 by Jack Sheets and transcribed by Pat Russell.
