

GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Evergreen – Division 4

This division of Evergreen is rectangular shaped, running from the paved road at the Grant St. entrance west to the north/south alley path which separates it from Division 3. It runs between its south and north borders-- the east/west alley path and the first paved roadway to the left of the Grant St. entrance. The reading covers blocks of two or more rows starting at the southwest corner and reading south to north and returning north to south, then moving east to the next row. There are many family stones that are grouped in an east/west configuration covering two or more rows. We have tried to include these all together in the same block reading. Read by Jack Sheets in 2002.
