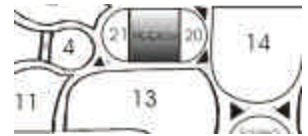


GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Hebrew Section

This is an oval shaped section in the south central part of the cemetery comprising a central rectangular area with a half circle at each end. (They are Sections 20 and 21) The three sections are not divided by roads. This rectangular center part was read east to west by rows starting at the very south edge. It was completed by Sandy Marshall in May of 2002.
