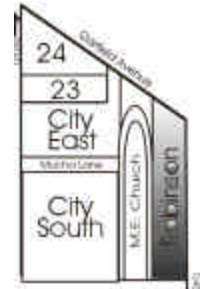


GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Robinson - Hill South

This section is at the extreme southern edge of the cemetery between the Grant Street Gate and the eastern fence at Garfield Avenue. It is a long, narrow section divided by pathways, and fenced or walled in family plots. It runs adjacent to the Methodist Church Section. The reading began at the eastern end in the corner where Grant and Garfield St. meet, reading west to the road at the Grant Street entrance, then back reading east. This was read by Joyce Daulton in 2001 and transcribed by Gladys Reynolds in 2002.
