

GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Holy Redeemer – Division B

Holy Redeemer is a large section on the west central side of the cemetery. It borders Offnere Street north of the main entrance. It is divided into a circle and six divisions. This division is northeast of the circle. It was read starting at Lot #21, north of the Circle along roadway, then S to N to where it connects to Division G, then back N to S. This division was read by Mary E. Flanagan in June 2002.
