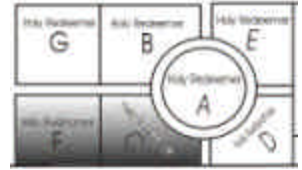


GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Holy Redeemer – Division C & F

Holy Redeemer is a large section on the west side of the cemetery. It borders Offnere Street, north of the main cemetery entrance. It is divided into a circle and six divisions. This part **includes Divisions C and F**--starting Division C at the closed gate, going north along Offnere and recording continuously through Division F which ends at a line of trees. We walked south to north between two rows of stones and recorded headstones and footstones for the same plots. Some stones are next to the fence, but some are across from them seemingly in the next row. The following row was read north to south, etc. Inscriptions were copied in April/May 2002 by Mary Flanagan, Gerald Martin, and Gladys Reynolds
