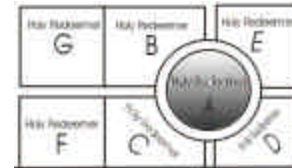


GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Holy Redeemer – Circular Division

Holy Redeemer is a large section on the west central side of the cemetery. It borders Offnere Street north of the main entrance. It is divided into a circle and six divisions. The circle is Division A. This was read starting with the two outer rows on the west side of the circle nearest Offnere St., going clockwise around the circle. This Division was read by Mary E. Flanagan in May, 2002.
