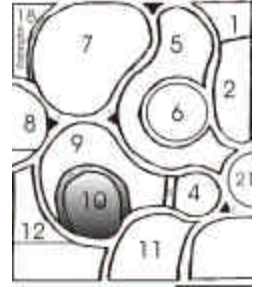


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY - Section 10 & Oak Avenue

Section 10 is in the central part of the cemetery. It is almost like a circle with the westerly end flattened out. The reading starts at the center and proceeds clockwise with each rotation called a numbered circle. The circles tend to flatten out close to the road. At the west end there was once a wide roadway between Section 10 and Section 9. This was originally Oak Avenue which now has burials. Gravestones in this circle are listed in cemetery records as in Oak Road and are listed at the end of Section 10. Read by Jack Sheets, 2002
