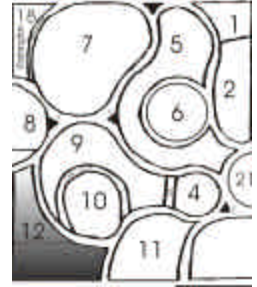


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY - Section 12

Section 12 is in the northwestern part of the cemetery. The stones are sparsely spaced in a somewhat random manner. The west side was originally a Pauper Section. The remaining eastern part was sold off for single graves. Remember to check our book of [Gravestone Inscriptions of the 1800s](#) for many stones in this section. Only burials of the 1900s are in this publication. The readers, Pamela Williams Clark and Ann S. Sydnor, began at the northwest corner, going from north to south in rows. March 2002.
