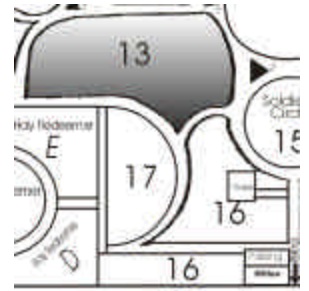


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY - Section 13

Section 13 is located in about the northwest section of the cemetery, just east of the chapel. The section was read beginning at the northwest corner, moving south, then moving back to the north.
