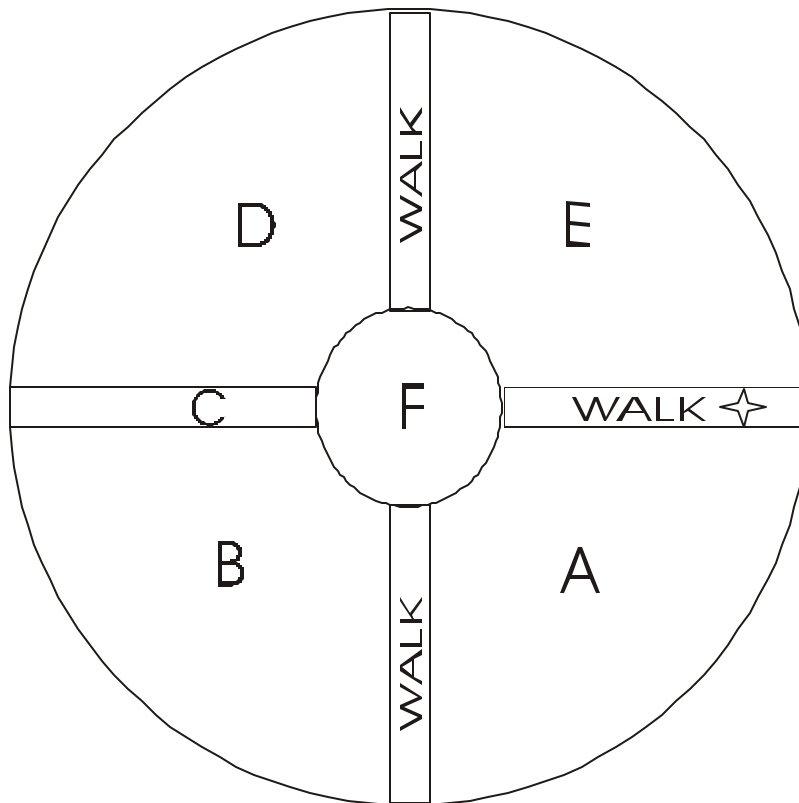


# GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Soldiers Circle - Section 15

Soldiers Circle was created as the result of the Civil War and was dedicated May 30, 1884 along with Greenlawn Chapel

The Greenlawn Chapel was built in 1884 for funerals of Civil War soldiers and other citizens. The special brick entrance was designed for horseshoes of the horse drawn hearses

It is now known that 46 Civil War Soldiers died and were buried here before 1870. Records show 2,309 soldier burials in Greenlawn Cemetery including those who fought in the following wars:

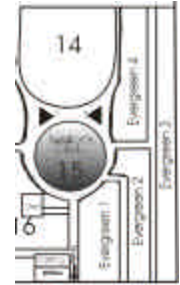

## GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Soldiers Circle - Section 15

This circular section lies directly east after entering the Offnere Street Gate. It includes only graves of United States soldiers. The section is easily distinguished by the large statue of the Union soldier in the center. The section was read by Judy Ross, 2002.

The soldier's names are in alphabetical order with the letters in the far left margin denoting what section the soldier is buried in. Please refer to the map at the beginning of this section.
