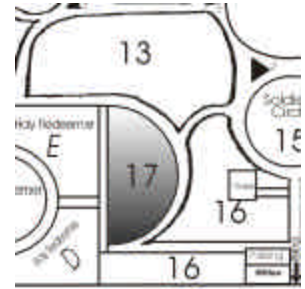


GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Section 17

Section 17 is located to the left of the main office after entering on the Offnere street side. This section is the shape of a half circle with the recordings beginning at the upper Northwest going around the circle southward to the northeast. Each successive half circle row is read in the same direction. The upper north of the section was in straight rows which had to be read from North to South. Inscriptions of the 1900's copied October 20, 2001 by Greta DuPuy
