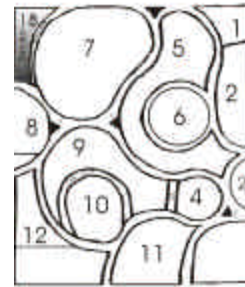


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Section 18 (Washington)

This section is in the northeast part of the cemetery between the St. Mary's Section & Section 7. It is between Section 8 on the west and Section 19 on the east. The dividing line between St. Mary's and Section 18 is blurred, but a dividing line starts at the small grave of Hope Virginia Sparks on the east side by the road and going east to Section 8. Stones to the north of that line are on the St. Mary's side. This section was recorded by Allison Kalb in 2002 beginning at the east end moving north to south.
