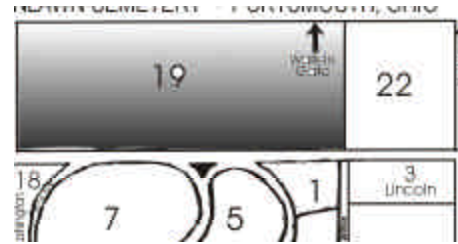


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Section 19

This section is located at the far east side of the cemetery. We read the section beginning at the back row, against the fence, going from south to north, and then north to south on the next row. Inscriptions were read by Jackie P. Journey and Joyce M. Sadler, April 2002.

This row begins in about the middle of the section and is located back against the fence by the alley.
