

GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Section 22

Section 22 is on the eastern border of the cemetery. If you enter at the Garfield St. Gate, Section 22 is to your right (north). It is one of the oldest sections of the cemetery. The rows were read starting on the west edge going east toward Garfield Ave. Each row was read from north to south by Janet and David Huffman, May, 2002.
