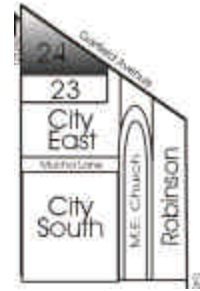


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Section 24
