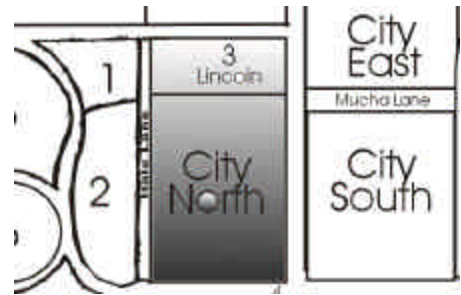


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY - Section 3, City North & Hale Lane

Section 3 and City North were once separate sections. Now the road that divided them has been used for graves, and the two seem as one. The best way to reach these sections is to enter at the Garfield Gate. At the first road turn right (north); immediately to your left (west) is Section 3/City North. The inscriptions were read starting at the SE corner reading south to north up to Hale Lane. Hale Lane was also a road which is now used for graves. It shows on the map between City North and Section 2. Inscriptions were read south to north on the Hale Lane Section, beginning at the SE corner. It is included at the end of this section. These were read and transcribed by Janice Edwards, 2002
