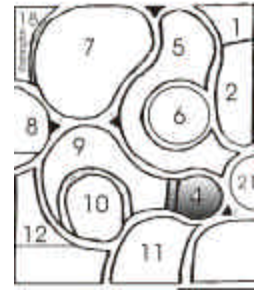


GREENLAWN CEMETERY - Section 4 & 4A

Section 4 is like a nickel at the most southern part of Section 9. As Section 4 is a circle type section, it was decided to start in the middle and work outward. This was done working counter clockwise and calling each rotation a numbered circle. Be aware that these circles are not true in the accurate definition of the word circle. There was a small roadway at the north end of Section 4, which has been converted to a new burial area and called Section 4A. Inscriptions for Section 4A are listed at the end of Section 4.
