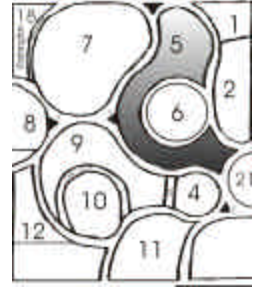


GREENLAWN CEMETERY - Section 5

This is an oblong section located in the east central section of the cemetery. It makes a half circle around Section 6. The reading starts at the southwestern point, moving first along the western edge, then reversing to the eastern border going northeast around the inner curve. Many stones are read from the road/alley recording the border stones, and those in the inner row also in line of sight. End of row lines may indicate a reversal of direction. The first part was read by Marge DeSostoa; the second part by Gary M. and Paula R. Shaw in March of 2002..
