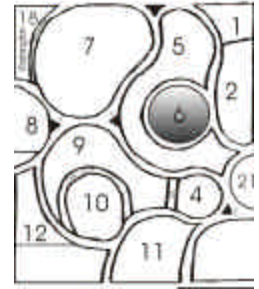


GREENLAWN CEMETERY - Section 6

Section 6 is a circular section in the center of the cemetery. It was read beginning with the outer circle at the south edge and going north clockwise around the circles. Many burials in this section were in the 1800s and can be found in our former publication. These burials of the 1900s were compiled and completed in April, 2002 by Dorothy Justus and Joyce Foster.
