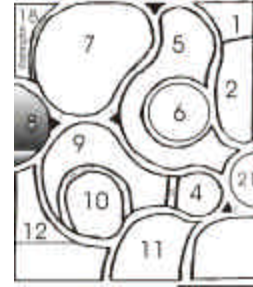


GREENLAWN CEMETERY - Section 8

Section 8 is in the north central part of the cemetery . It is the shape of a semicircle and was read beginning at the northwest corner where Section 8 meets St. Mary's, moving southeast in semi-circular rows. A small, flat, white stone lettered, "German Catholic 1889" (Indicated in Row 11) provides a marker delineating St. Mary's from Section 8 as well as the line where it meets Section A. Section 8 was read by Allison Kalb in 2002.
