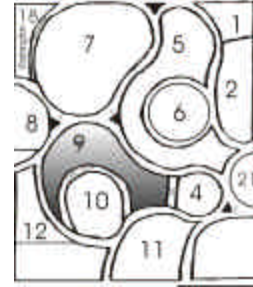


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY - Section 9

Section 9 almost circles Section 10. The reading begins at the northwest end of the section with the flat headstone of James and Fannie Martin, which is located beside the south-north road, directly across from a tree that is in Section 12. The rows are read in a clockwise direction, and go in an "arc" around the section, with each row being read beginning at the northwest end of the section to the southwest end of the section. Read by Jack Sheets in 2002
