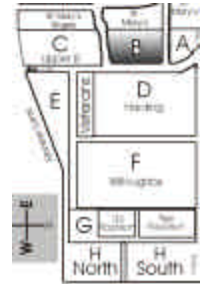


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Section B
