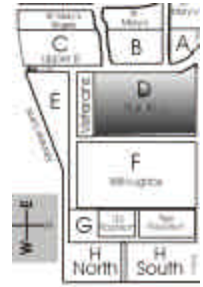


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Section D - Harding
