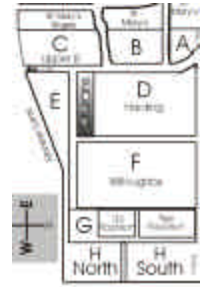


GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Section D – Veterans
