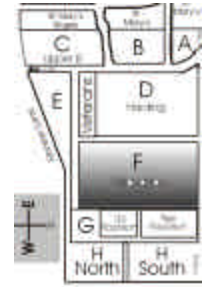


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Section F
