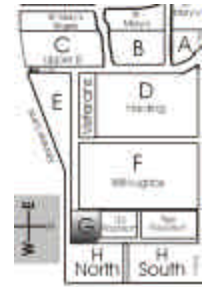


## GREENLAWN CEMETERY – Section G
