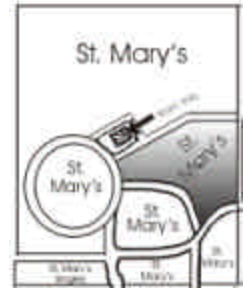


GREENLAWN CEMETERY - St. Mary's Section – 8 - German Catholic Cemetery
