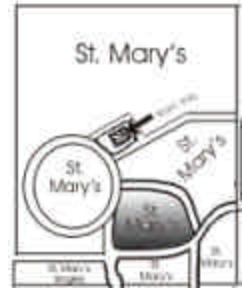


GREENLAWN CEMETERY – St. Mary’s Section - NE - German Catholic Cemetery
