

GREENLAWN CEMETERY - City South Section

Only burials 1900 and prior were listed, unless they were on the same stone or immediately next to an apparent spouse who died before 1900. Questionable engraving is underlined, as quite a few of the stones were eroded or broken. These inscriptions were listed August 1982 by Caryn R. Shoemaker, CGRS, Jonathan Shoemaker and Jody Shoemaker. Inscriptions were given in order as they are physically located in rows.
