

GREENLAWN CEMETERY - Evergreen (1)

There are five sections on the map of the cemetery that are labeled Evergreen. This section is located by entering the Grant Street Gate. It is the second section to the left after entering the gate. The inscriptions were copied in September, 1983 by Jean Seeley. They start with the row nearest Offnere Street and proceed eastward.
