

GREENLAWN CEMETERY - Hill North Section (Methodist)

This section appears on the map as Hill Section. It lies directly south of Sections #23-24. It is a long, narrow lot that runs from Garfield Avenue to the main road through the cemetery, entering through the Grant Avenue gate. These stones were copied in July, 1982 by Jean Seeley.
