

## GREENLAWN CEMETERY - Hill South Section (Robinson)

This section is located in the corner of Garfield Avenue and Grant Street. It appears on the map as Hill Section. Inscriptions were taken starting in the northeastern corner and working southwestward by rows. The inscriptions were abstracted in September, 1982 by Jean Seeley.

Erected in 1960 by the Scioto County Historical Society with the aid of civic minded citizens of the city.
